Chris' kind heart and fun-loving nature inspired his friends to establish The Big Goose Open non-profit organization. CRITERIA: Scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior moving onto the post- secondary level. Student will be chosen on the criteria of:

1. Community involvement 2. Academic Achievements. 3. Why you chose your field of study

Scholarship will be paid out in one installments directly to the institution of study upon enrollment of the second semester. In the case of one-year technical education, other arrangements will be made with the Big Goose Open Board of Directors.

Selection will be a two-step process:

1. We will narrow down candidates through this application.
